BYLAW NUMBER 715-2009

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BASHAW, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
TO ADOPT THE
TOWN OF BASHAW / CAMROSE COUNTY
INTER-MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, provides that two or more Councils may, by each passing a Bylaw, adopt an Inter-municipal Development Plan;

AND WHEREAS, Council deems it desirable to adopt an Inter-municipal Development Plan with Camrose County;

AND WHEREAS, Council recognizes that the lands contained within the Inter-municipal Development Plan will remain under the jurisdiction of Camrose County, and that the Inter-municipal Development Plan provides a basis for cooperation and communication on matters of mutual interest;

AND WHEREAS, notice of the proposed Bylaw and Public Hearing was given pursuant to Section 606(2) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta;

AND WHEREAS, a Joint Public Hearing into the proposed Bylaw is to be held April 28, 2009 at the Camrose County Office prior to second and third reading of Bylaw 715-2009;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Bashaw duly assembled enacts as follows:

THAT THE TOWN OF BASHAW / CAMROSE COUNTY INTER-MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN, AS ATTACHED AND FORMING PART OF THIS BYLAW BE ADOPTED.
