Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit:

- ✓ WATER; 4 liters of water per person per day, for at least three days, for drinking & sanitation
- ✓ FOOD; at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- ✓ Battery-powered RADIO and a Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- ✓ FLASHLIGHT & extra BATTERIES
- ✓ FIRST AID KIT
- ✓ Whistle and signal for help
- ✓ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air, and, plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ✓ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- ✓ Basic TOOLS needed to turn off utilities (wrench, pliers, etc.)
- ✓ Can opener for food
- ✓ Local MAPS

Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Preparedness Supply Kit:

- ✓ Prescription medications & glasses
- ✓ Infant formula and diapers
- ✓ Pet food & water for your pet
- ✓ Important family documents (copies of insurance policies, ID, & bank account records in a waterproof & portable container)
- ✓ Cash or traveler's checks
- ✓ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person
- ✓ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants, & comfortable shoes
- ✓ Household chlorine bleach & medicine dropper – When diluted 9 parts water to 1 part bleach, bleach can be used as a disinfectant. Or in an emergency, you can use it to treat water by using 16 drops of regular household liquid bleach per gallon of water. Do not use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners.
- ✓ Fire Extinguisher

- ✓ Matches in a waterproof container
- ✓ Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- ✓ Mess kits, paper towels, paper cups, plates & plastic utensils
- ✓ Paper & pen/ pencil
- ✓ Books, games, puzzles or other activities for your family
