## LANDOWNER REQUEST FOR SUBDIVISION EXTENSION

The *Municipal Government Act*, Section 657 specifies that Council can approve a subdivision extension request, at their discretion, with no limits on number of extensions, length of extensions, or when they can accept a request. To provide guidance to administration and the public, the following policies will apply to subdivision extension requests in the municipality.

## **Notice and Acceptance of Subdivision Extension Requests**

- 1. The County Planning Department shall notify applicants, in writing, of any application for subdivision that is set to expire, at least 30 days in advance.
- 2. The County Planning Department shall not accept a subdivision extension request after the subdivision approval has expired.
- 3. The applicant must submit a subdivision extension request, in writing, outlining the reasons for the request, including what conditions have been completed, and the applicable application fee.

## **Designation of Authority for Subdivision Extensions**

- The County Planning Department, shall approve the first request for a subdivision extension. The approval will extend the subdivision for 1 year. However, if extenuating circumstances arise, the County Planning Department shall take the request to the Municipal Council for decision. The Municipal Council may, or may not, approve the request.
- 2. The Municipal Council may approve an additional 2 subdivision extension requests. The Municipal Council can determine the length of the time extension, provided it does not contravene #4. Approvals will be based on merit and evidence proving that the applicant is actively working on the subdivision.
- 3. The municipality shall not approve more than 3 subdivision extensions.
- 4. The maximum subdivision extension shall not exceed 5 years from the date of the initial subdivision approval. Any request beyond that will require a new subdivision application.
